

As you prepare for your quilting class, you'll need to decide on the size of the quilt you want to make: crib or lap sized. Keep in mind that if you choose to create a lap-sized quilt, you may need to invest more time on homework to ensure that you finish within the timeframe of the series.

What is a fat quarter?

A fat quarter is a pre-cut piece of fabric used in quilting and sewing projects. It is called a "fat" quarter because it is cut from a yard of fabric that is already 44 inches wide. Instead of cutting a long, skinny strip that measures 9 inches by 44 inches, for example, a fat quarter is cut to measure 18 inches by 22 inches. This size is more versatile for creating quilting and sewing projects because it allows for larger pieces of fabric to be used while still providing a variety of colors and patterns to choose from. Fat quarters are commonly sold in bundles and are a popular choice for quilters and sewers of all skill levels. *If you're unable to find fat quarters, you can purchase 1/2 yard cuts instead.

What else do I need for class?

- Batting: Natural Cotton Batting (sold by the yard, comes 90" wide): Crib Size: 1.5 yards, Lap Size 2 yards
- Thread: Cotton or Cotton/Poly 50 wt. (Gutermann is an excellent brand, choose a shade that blends with your background fabric--neutrals work well)
- Quilting Pins: Clover brand
- Curved Safety Pins: Dritz brand

We provide you with the items below, but feel free to bring your own if preferred:

- Sewing Machine
- Quilting Rulers: 6x24" + 6x12"
- Rotary Cutter with fresh blade
- Embroidery scissors or thread snips
