Technique Sampler Class

In Learn to Sew III, we're shifting gears from completing one large project to focusing entirely on mastering advanced sewing techniques. Unlike our previous Learn to Sew I and II classes, where we worked on single projects from start to finish, this class is all about perfecting specific skills. You'll practice each technique on smaller fabric swatches. These swatches will allow you to hone each skill—like sewing different types of zippers, creating buttonholes, and mastering various seam finishes—without the pressure of a larger project. As you progress, you'll compile these swatches into a Technique Binder, creating a comprehensive collection of your work. This binder will not only showcase the techniques you've learned but also serve as a handy reference for future sewing projects.

Technique Sampler Supply List

Yardage:

- (2) 1/2 yard cuts of 100% cotton fabric (choose something fun to learn on)
- 1/2 yard cut of denim fabric
- 1/2 yard cut of a light weight WOVEN fusible interfacing
- 1/2 yard cut of a light weight NON-WOVEN fusible interfacing

Notions:

- All purpose thread (Gutterman All Purpose works great)
- 12" standard zipper
- 12" invisible zipper
- (3) 1/2" buttons
- (3) 1" buttons
- pack of 1" wide non-roll elastic
- 3 ring binder + sleeve protectors
